### HOW TO MAKE VISITORS WELCOMED

What can you do to make visitors here at CPC feel welcome? Becoming a warm and welcoming church is spontaneous and intentional!

1. As we often say...look for those you may not know, who may be visiting.
2. Make an effort to communicate a welcoming comment to visitors, even if it means waiting for others to finish greeting them. The more greeters we have, the more welcome they feel.
3. Bypass your friends for a few minutes after the service so you can speak with visitors. Your friends will be there afterwards but visitors are quick to slip out if they don't have a conversation offered to them. Give them a reason to stay.
4. Express personal interest. Ask the visitor where they live, ask where they are from and if they are new to our community. Perhaps suggest how you might help them get oriented, what local places to check out, where to shop, etc.
5. Notice their kids...make sure the children feel warmly welcomed also.
6. Offer assistance. Point out or escort them to destinations like the Welcome Center in the lobby, the Pastor's Class, the nursery, or the children's Sunday School classes. Even a tour of our facilities might be welcomed by visitors. Invite them home with you for a bite of lunch...how radical is that!
